Additional Data Request Response

Kuhn's Moving Service (KMS) will adhere to the minimum requirements for drivers and vehicles involved in the transportation of property and passengers by motor carrier, as determined by the Title 52 Pennsylvania Code on Public Utility. These policies have been reviewed, and a printed copy of relevant sections will be kept on-hand with company documents.

1A. As stated in 52 PA Code § 37.204, 49 CFR 391.11, KMS drivers must be at least 18 years of age to operate motor vehicles under KMS. All employees must provide a copy of a legal and valid driver's license to operate any transportation vehicle, which will be stored in the driver's qualification file. KMS will never transport hazardous materials.

1B-1C. A driving history will be obtained and reviewed annually to ensure all employees meet the minimum requirements for safe driving. KMS will also require updated medical cards to ensure employees operating commercial motor vehicles are physically fit to do so. These will be conducted by a licensed physician. A note, including the name of the person who performed the review of the driving record required and the date of such review, shall be maintained in the driver's qualification file. Background checks will be completed as part of the hiring process of all employees to make informed decisions on acquisition, reduce risk and guard against liability claims. A record will be obtained from the Pennsylvania State Police and from every other state in which the person resided for the last 12 months. Following receipt of the initial criminal history record, KMS shall obtain and review a criminal history record for each employee providing moving services every 2 years from the date of the last criminal history check. A copy of all records will be maintained for at least 3 years. The full driving and criminal history report will be pulled via online background screenings such as Justifacts or GoodHire.

2. Following the acceptance of our PUC application, KMS intends to purchase a moving truck to be used for all services. Purchased vehicles will be non CDL. Vehicles owned and operated by KMS will be required to adhere to the following, but not limited to:

- Every motor vehicle operated by KMS shall be marked on each side, in letters at least 2 inches in height, and at least 1/2 inch in width, the name and address of the motor carrier and the number of the certificate of public convenience or permit as follows: "PA. P.U.C. NO. A."
- Yearly inspections and emissions to be conducted on every vehicle
- Minimum insurance coverage of motor carriers of household goods shall meet the requirements of 75 PA C.S. § 1711
- A pre-trip driver's inspection report outlined by J.J. Keller & Associates, Inc. ("Keller Premium") will be performed prior to execution of job. Each checklist must be dated, marked and signed by driver. A copy of the inspection report will be stored in operating vehicle for the duration of trip.

If rented vehicles were needed to operate, please see the following actions defined by KMS to allow for pre-trip inspection of rented vehicles.

- As stated by 52 PA Code § 31.33, there shall be marked on each side of the vehicle, in letters at least 2 inches in height and at least 1/2 inch in width, the wording: "OPERATED BY (name and address of authorized motor carrier), PA. P.U.C. NO. A _____." If a removable device is used to identify the operating carrier as lessee, the device shall be of durable material and securely affixed, to the vehicle operated, throughout the duration of the lease.
- Same driver's inspection report to be conducted, as stated previously
