**Re: Petition of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation for Approval of its Act 129 Phase IV Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plan
Docket No. M-2020-3020824**

To All Parties of Record:

On September 19, 2024, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (PPL) filed a Petition for Approval of a Minor Change to its Act 129 Phase IV Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plan (Petition) in the above-captioned matter.


Our review of the filing and the attached Certificate of Service revealed that it appears that the Petition was not served on the Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (I&E), as required by the Commission's Order in *Energy Efficiency and Conservation Program*, Docket No. M-2008-2069887 (Order entered June 10, 2011) (*Minor Plan Change Order*) at 18. Although the Petition, which included an executed Verification, stated that PPL was serving a copy of the filing on the Pennsylvania Office of Consumer Advocate, the Pennsylvania Office of Small Business Advocate, I&E and all parties of record, *see* Petition at 7, Para. No. 31, the Cover Letter and Certificate of Service submitted with the filing do not list I&E as a party that was served with the Petition by PPL.

Consequently, out of an abundance of caution, and to ensure that due process is adequately provided, we direct PPL, within five (5) days, of the issuance of this Secretarial Letter, if not sooner, to: (1) properly serve I&E with the Petition filed on September 19, 2024; or (2) file proof with the Commission's Secretary that I&E was properly served with the Petition in accordance with the *Minor Plan Change Order*. Subsequently, if it was not originally served with the Petition, I&E, if it so chooses, shall have fifteen (15) days from the date of service of the Petition to file comments on the proposed minor Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plan change pursuant to the *Minor Change Order*,¹

¹ In the event I&E files comments to the Petition, all interested parties may file reply comments as provided in the *Minor Plan Change Order*. *See Minor Plan Change Order* at 19.

see Minor Change Order at 19, or it is free to inform the Commission at any time that it will not be filing comments.
