Enclosed are reports on the Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania's 2024 Meter Sampling program for Class A, B and C meters.

The Class A meters followed the same statistical sampling plan as in previous years, and results are included in the table on the following page. American Class B meters were formerly in the variable interval program, but moved to the statistical sampling program this year.

The 2024 Class B and Class C variable interval program results are also included. All meters in the Class B and C Miscellaneous families are retired from service once they are removed.
