Dear Attorney Sniscak:

On January 23, 2025, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) served notice to Appalachian Utilities, Inc. (AUI) that the Commission did not receive a Lead Service Line Replacement (LSLR) program petition from your organization by the required deadline. Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 65.55(a), a Class B public utility, Class C public utility or municipal corporation was required to file an LSLR program petition by July 22, 2024. The Commission subsequently received your letter dated February 20, 2025, that requested a 90-day time extension for AUI to file its Lead Service Line Replacement Program (LSLR Program). Please be advised your request is hereby granted, and AUI's LSLR Program petition is now due by May 21, 2025.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition for reconsideration of the actions of staff with the Commission within 20 days of the date this letter is served. Should you have any questions, please contact Matthew T.
