
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Warwick Township Municipal Authority, of 315 Clay Road, Lititz, Pennsylvania 17543, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars and 50/100 (\$2,773.50) in hand paid by **PPL Electric Utilities Corporation**, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby remise, release, quitclaim and forever discharge the said PPL Electric Utilities Corporation, its respective officers, agents, employees, successors, assigns and all persons or entities, whether or not named herein, who may be jointly or severally liable, of and from all suits, claims, demands, actions, damages and claims for damages or contribution whatsoever arising out of or resulting from any injury, loss or damage that may have been caused to crops, grain, land, and personal property **and for attorney fees** in the Township of Warwick, County of Lancaster, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by reason of the construction, reconstruction and/or maintenance by the said PPL Electric Utilities Corporation of its overhead and/or underground electric line facilities, upon, over, under and across said property to the day of the date of these presents. Owner shall maintain in the strictest confidence the terms of this Agreement, including the amount payable hereunder.

This Agreement is between a public utility and a municipal corporation and is therefore subject to Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“PUC”) review pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S.A. § 507. The Effective Date of this Agreement shall be the later of i) thirty (30) days from the date that PPL submits the Agreement to the PUC; or ii) if the PUC opens an investigation of the Agreement, on the date the PUC approves the Agreement.
