STATUS REPORT OF DUQUESNE LIGHT COMPANY

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE JEFFREY A. WATSON:

Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light” or the “Company”) submits the following Status Report, pursuant to the Interim Order Granting Respondent’s Request To Continue Evidentiary Hearing dated December 6, 2024, entered in this proceeding (“Interim Order”). The Interim Order requires the Parties to report on the status of settlement negotiations between the Parties and to identify any other issues that need to be addressed at this stage of the proceeding.

Between December 4, 2024, and February 28, 2025, Duquesne Light has attempted to contact Nicole Mercurio (“Complainant”) on numerous occasions in an attempt to investigate the high billing claims raised in her Complaint. Specifically, the Company and its Counsel have attempted to contact her via phone call, email, and letter to schedule an energy audit and a foreign load investigation at her service address. Although voice mails were left for the Complainant and the correspondence was not returned as undeliverable, to date the Complainant has not been responsive to the Company’s attempted contacts. Duquesne Light continues to believe that conducting the energy audit and foreign load investigation could resolve the Complainant’s high billing concerns and help the Parties reach settlement. However, given the Complainant’s

unresponsiveness to the Company's attempts to contact her regarding these matters, Duquesne Light respectfully requests that this matter be set for evidentiary hearing.

Duquesne Light respectfully requests that Administrative Law Judge Jeffrey A. Watson accept this Status Report.
