Dear Senator Baker and Representative Olsommer:


Thank you for your letter dated March 4, 2024, regarding the rate increase proposal for natural gas and electricity filed by Pike County Light and Power with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC) at the above-referenced docket numbers.

These matters have been suspended for investigation and assigned to the Office of Administrative Law Judge for hearings. Since these matters are now contested proceedings pending before the PUC, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code prohibits ex-parte communications at 66 Pa. C.S. Section 334(c). Therefore, members of the PUC are prohibited from responding to correspondence or discussing issues regarding Pike County Light and Power's rate increase proposal.

Please be advised that I am placing your letter dated March 4, 2024, and this letter of response on the record of the above-referenced docket numbers to cure any possible ex-parte communications, and to also make public your concerns and comments regarding the rate increase proposal filed by Pike County Light and Power.
