The enclosed gas meter change information for Peoples Gas is supplied in accordance with Section 59.21(d) of the Commission's Gas Regulations, 52 Pa. Code Section 59.21(d), Statistical sampling for Class A, Class B or Class C meters.

The annual Statistical Sampling program for Peoples Gas Class A and Class B meters required 2,365 meters to be changed. Peoples exceeded the plan by changing an additional 16,663 meters in 2024.

The remaining 42 poor performing meters that have been identified will be removed from our system and retired as outlined in section in Section 59.21 (d) (i) of the Commission's Gas Regulations.
