Dear Attorney Klock:

By Order entered February 28, 2025, the Commission granted, in part, and denied, in part, the Petition filed by PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (the Company) at the above docket, seeking a waiver of its Distribution System Improvement Charge (DSIC) cap. On March 3, 2025, the Company filed Supplement No. 390 to Tariff Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. 201 to become effective March 13, 2025, proposing language revisions consistent with the Order. The supplement also proposes to increase the DSIC charge for the period March 13, 2025 through March 31, 2025.¹

Commission Staff has reviewed the proposed language revisions in accordance with the Order and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, the proposed language revisions are allowed to become effective by operation of law. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
