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

Dear Ms. Burge:

The Commission is in receipt of the Petition of WHC PA LLC t/a Z Trip Pittsburgh for Emergency Order dated March 6, 2025 (“Petition”). The Petition was filed pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 3.1-3.3 (relating to emergency relief and ex parte emergency orders). On March 4, 2025, the Commission issued a Cancellation Notice which cancelled Z Trip’s Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) based in its failure to respond to the December 3, 2024 Complaint at Docket No. C-2024-3050978. As a result, in the Petition, Z Trip is seeking the issuance of *ex parte* emergency relief that reinstates its CPC pending reconsideration of the original Cancellation Notice and permitting Z Trip to continue offering Call or Demand service as a common carrier.

The Petition has been filed pursuant to inapplicable provisions of the Commission’s regulations. The appropriate procedure for a motor carrier seeking the relief sought in the Petition would be an application for emergency temporary authority pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 3.383 (relating to applications for temporary authority and emergency temporary authority). Accordingly, the Commission is rejecting this instant filing as being defective and improper.
