Application of the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for approval to alter the public crossing (DOT 843 019 V) by replacement of the existing structure with a concrete box culvert where Railroad Street crosses, at grade, a track of SEDA-COG Joint Rail Authority, operated on by the Nittany and Bald Eagle Railroad, in Bellefonte Borough, Centre County, and the allocation of costs incident thereto.

To Whom It May Concern:

In accordance with Numbered Paragraph 3 of the Commission's Secretarial Letter dated May 18, 2022, in the above-captioned proceeding, Pennsylvania Department of Transportation on behalf of Centre County has submitted final construction plans, structural plans, and shoring plans to this Commission for approval of work proposed within the limits of the Commission's jurisdiction prior to the start of construction.

The final construction plans are entitled "CENTRE COUNTY DRAWINGS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF RAILROAD STREET IN BELLEFONTE BOROUGH AND SUNNYSIDE BOULEVARD IN BELLEFONTE BOROUGH," consisting of nine (9) sheets that were submitted to the Commission on February 19, 2025.

The final structural plans are entitled "CENTRE COUNTY BELLEFONTE BOROUGH RAILROAD STREET STA 15+33.76 OVER BUFFALO RUN 26'-0" X 6'-6" PRECAST RC BOX CULVERT," consisting of fifteen (15) sheets that were submitted to the Commission on February 19, 2025.

The final shoring plans are entitled "CENTRE COUNTY MULTI-MODAL BRIDGE REPLACEMENTS RAILROAD STREET OVER BUFFALO RUN L-434D TESPS," consisting of six (6) sheets that were submitted to the Commission on February 19, 2025.

The Department avers that each party to the proceeding was served a copy of the final construction and structural plans. The Department E-filed the plans with the Commission. None of the parties have advised this Commission that it objects to approval of the plans.

Please be advised that the final construction plans, structural plans, and shoring plans have been certified as the correct plans and are hereby approved.

The Commission issues this Secretarial Letter in accordance with Section 2702 of the Public Utility Code and approves the detailed construction plans submitted by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation

The Parties are reminded that failure to comply with this or any Order or Secretarial Letter in this proceeding may result in an enforcement action seeking civil penalties and/or other sanctions pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 3301.

All formal documents must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission. Documents must be eFiled, mailed or hand delivered. All filings should be addressed to the Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. The Commission will not accept documents delivered by fax or by e-mail. Parties are encouraged to file formal documents by eFiling with the Secretary of the Commission by opening an eFiling account through the Commission's website (the account is free of charge) and accepting eservice at <https://www.puc.pa.gov/filing-resources/efiling/>.

If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to file by overnight delivery to ensure the timely filing of your submission. There are certain filings that cannot be eFiled, such as filings containing confidential or proprietary material. These must be submitted to the Secretary by overnight delivery, priority, or certified mail to allow tracking of your filing.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.31 and 5.44, file a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The Petition shall be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission or sent to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, and must be filed within twenty (20) days, or if no timely request is made, the action will be deemed to be a final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request; (2) the case docket number (it is provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter); (3) the party on whose behalf the petition is made; (4) a Certificate of Service on the other parties of record; and (5) a Verification with original signature in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36.
