

**STATUS REPORT OF THE YORK WATER COMPANY,
THE OFFICE OF CONSUMER ADVOCATE,
AND THE OFFICE OF SMALL BUSINESS ADVOCATE**

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE KATRINA L. DUNDERDALE:

The York Water Company (“York Water” or the “Company”) submits the following Status Report, pursuant to Prehearing Order #1 entered in this proceeding on November 5, 2024. York Water has been authorized to present this Status Report on its behalf as well as on behalf of the Office of Consumer Advocate (“OCA”) and the Office of Small Business Advocate (“OSBA”) (“collectively the “Parties”).

I. Introduction

On November 5, 2024, Administrative Law Judge Katrina L. Dunderdale (the “ALJ”) issued Prehearing Order #1 stating that the Parties have until Friday January 10, 2024 to discuss the potential settlement of this matter, that the parties must file with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) a status report about the status of settlement discussions and discovery on or before January 10, 2025, and that the Parties must e-mail a status report to the ALJ every sixty days thereafter. On January 10, 2025, the Parties filed their first Status Report.


II. Status Report

The Parties in this proceeding are continuing to engage in settlement negotiations. The Company remains willing to work with the Parties through informal discovery processes to expedite any additional discovery and facilitate settlement discussions.

III. Conclusion

WHEREFORE, The York Water Company, the Office of Consumer Advocate, and the Office of Small Business Advocate, hereby jointly request that Administrative Law Judge Katrina L. Dunderdale accept this Status Report as the Parties work toward settlement.
