

NOTICE OF MOTOR CARRIER COMPLAINT

- A. You must file an Answer within twenty (20) days of the date of service of this Complaint. The date of service is the mailing date as indicated at the top of the Secretarial Cover Letter for this Complaint and Notice, 52 Pa. Code §1.56(a). An Answer is a written explanation of circumstances wished to be considered in determining the outcome. The Answer should raise all factual and legal arguments that you wish to claim in your defense and must include the reference number of this Complaint. Your Answer must be verified and the original **mailed to:**

- B. If you fail to answer this Complaint within twenty (20) days, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement will request that the Commission issue a Secretarial Letter imposing a penalty. The penalty could include a fine, the suspension or revocation of your certificate of public convenience, or other such remedy.
- C. You may elect not to contest this Complaint by paying the fine proposed in this Complaint by certified check or money order. **Payment must be made to "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania"** and forwarded to:

- D. Your payment is an admission that you committed the alleged violation and an agreement to cease and desist from further violations. Upon receipt of your payment, the Complaint proceeding shall be closed.
- E. If you file an Answer, which admits or fails to deny the allegations of the Complaint, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement will request that the Commission issue a Secretarial Letter imposing a fine and/or other such remedy.
- F. If you file an Answer which contests the Complaint, the matter will be assigned to an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) for hearing and decision. The ALJ is not bound by the optional fine set forth above.

MOTOR CARRIER COMPLAINT

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “PUC”) is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate public utilities within the Commonwealth. The Commission has delegated its authority to initiate proceedings which are prosecutory in nature to the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and other bureaus with enforcement responsibilities. Pursuant to that delegated authority and Section 701 of the Public Utility Code, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement – Motor Carrier Division hereby represents as follows:

1. That PRECISION TRANSPORT LLC, Respondent, maintains a principal address of 200 Airside Drive, Ste 260, Moon Township, PA 15108.
2. That on October 4, 2024, by Commission Secretarial letter, Respondent was issued a certificate of public convenience by this Commission authorizing transportation, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, property, excluding household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania at PUC Utility Code 8927432, at Docket No. A-2024-3051270.
3. That on December 16, 2024, and December 18, 2024, PUC Enforcement Officer Andrew Rosenberger, after being assigned a Safety Fitness Review (“SFR”), phoned the Respondent, leaving a voicemail each time. On December 23, 2024, a letter was sent by certified mail, asking the Respondent to contact Officer Rosenberger. On February 24, 2025, the return mail card from the certified letter was received in the Western Regional Office. Officer Rosenberger drove to the Respondent’s place of business, discovering that the office was empty and abandoned. No contact has been made by the Respondent to these attempts.
4. **Error! Bookmark not defined.** That Respondent, by failing to respond to and achieve a satisfactory evaluation on a safety fitness review, violated 66 Pa. Code §§501(c) & 504. The penalty for this violation is cancellation of the certificate held by Respondent with this Commission at Utility Code 8927432.

WHEREFORE, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement hereby requests that the Commission revoke the certificate of public convenience issued to PRECISION TRANSPORT LLC at PUC Utility Code 8927432.
