RE: Borough of Ambler Water Requirement to File an Annual Asset Optimization Plan

Dear Adeolu A. Bakare:

On March 4, 2025, the Borough of Ambler (Ambler) filed a letter (March 4 Letter) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) at Docket No. P-2023-3041666 regarding its requirement to file an Annual Asset Optimization Plan (AAOP) pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 121.6. Ambler requested that the Commission, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.43, grant Ambler a limited waiver for this filing requirement through March of 2026.

On March 17, 2025, following discussion with Commission Staff, Ambler filed a letter (March 17 Letter) to Docket No. P-2023-3041666 amending the March 4 Letter and instead requesting a 60-day extension of this year's AAOP filing deadline through April 30, 2025. Ambler noted that it is working with experienced consultants to finalize a compliant filing by the requested extension date. Upon review of Ambler's March 17 Letter, the Commission hereby grants Ambler an extension to file its required AAOP on or before April 30, 2025.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition with the Commission within twenty (20) days after the date of this letter.
