Dear Special Agent Mroczka:

The Complainant in the above-referenced matter, Clovernote Holdings, LLC, was previously not represented by counsel. Sometime late last year or early this year, Mr. Eckenrode, the principal of Clovernote Holdings, LLC, contacted Attorney Kenneth J. Yarsky, II, of our firm to represent him in connection with this matter. Mr. Yarsky began collecting information and meeting with Mr. Eckenrode. Then, on January 31, 2025, Mr. Yarsky suffered a serious fall. Mr. Yarsky was in the hospital for some time, and is now in a rehabilitation facility. Additionally, since his fall, Mr. Yarsky has been unable to attend to any of the legal matters which he was handling.

Sometime at the end of February 2025, other members of the firm became aware of this pending matter. I have now assumed responsibility for the matter. However, I do not yet have a full understanding of the case and have not yet had the opportunity to fully review the filings, the evidentiary documents or to discuss it with the Complainant.

I have been in contact with Attorney John F. Povilaitis, who represents Hudson Energy Services, LLC. Mr. Povilaitis has informed me that Hudson has no objection to the requested continuance. I have also communicated with Attorney Megan E. Rulli, who represents Duquesne Light Company. She has informed me that Duquesne Light consents to the request.

I respectfully request a continuance of the telephonic hearing currently scheduled for March 28, 2025. The reason for the request is my need to become familiar with the file and to be able to properly prepare for the hearing and represent the Complainant. Additionally, it is my hope that I can work with the other parties to this matter to resolve it before a hearing takes place.

Finally, I have conferred with all counsel and we respectfully request that the hearing be rescheduled to May 8 or May 9, 2025, if your schedule can accommodate that.
