REPLIES TO EXCEPTIONS OF
YOLONDA JONES v. PPL ELECTRIC UTILITIES CORPORATION

I am writing to formally appeal the denial of my request for a new payment arrangement on my account. I understand that my initial request was denied however due to recent changes since I had my hearing, I'm requesting reconsideration.

My financial situation has made it extremely difficult to make any payments and I'm asking for a new agreement with a payment plan I can afford.

Here are a few things that have contributed to my hardship and will have an impact on my future plan:

I am a current Federal Government employee. There is a lot of uncertainty with my job. It's like a huge cloud over my head not knowing if I will lose my job. My agency has fired over 1,500 people with more layoffs to come. I have attached memorandums that speak of the Reduction In Force happening around the country in every Federal Agency. I don't know if I will have a job in a few months.

After my father took ill and his sudden death was a strain on my fiance.

I do not have a part time job anymore. I've had to return to the office in person, commuting full time five days a week so there's no time to work a second job. It's just my salary in the house.

I'm very concerned and stressed about my current job situation. I don't know if I will have a job therefore that would make it difficult for me to come up with a lump sum payment. It's also not fair to assume that I will default on a new arrangement. I'm requesting another chance with a revised payment plan that allows me to make consistent manageable payments each month. Is it possible to set up a recurring payment on the back balance?
