Dear Mr. Bakare:

On March 25, 2025, Citizens' Electric Company of Lewisburg, PA, and Wellsboro Electric Company (collectively Companies), filed the results of their Request for Proposals (RFP) process and rules for the Spring 2025 Solicitation for provider of last resort. The filing includes proposed bid results for the Supplier Adder for supply for two classes of default customers: customer with demands of 400 kW or more and with demand below 400 kW who receive default service for the period of June 1, 2025 through May 31, 2029.

This filing is submitted in accordance with the Companies' Default Service Plan VII RFP Process and Rules filed on September 24, 2024, as part of a Joint Petition for Settlement. The RFP Process and Rules were approved by Commission Order, entered January 23, 2025, at Docket Nos. P-2024-3049357 and P-2024-3049359.


The Companies request that the Commission approve the bid results from the Spring 2025 Solicitation on or before March 27, 2025.

Further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time, since the results of the Spring 2025 Solicitation appear to have been conducted in accordance with the RFP Process and Rules as approved by the Commission.

Therefore, we direct the Companies to disclose the results of the Spring 2025 Solicitation in accordance with the Commission's Secretarial Letter in Re: Disclosure of Default Service Solicitation Results and Creation of a Default Service Rate Calculation Model, issued October 12, 2010, at Docket No. M-2009-2082042.
