**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE**

This Order grants a continuance in this case.

On March 8, 2024, Clifton Bennett (Complainant) filed a Formal Complaint, alleging that his bills from PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (Respondent) contained incorrect charges and challenging the budget billing.

On April 15, 2024, the Respondent filed an Answer to the Formal Complaint denying the material allegations of the Complaint.

An Initial Hearing was to have been held in this case on March 31, 2025. On March 24, 2025, the Complainant, via letter, submitted a Motion for Continuance of the hearing in the matter due to the fact that the Complainant has been experiencing major medical issues and is not able to prepare for the hearing. The Respondent indicated that it does not oppose the continuance request.

The Commission’s Rule of Administrative Practice and Procedure at 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b) states that, “Only for good cause shown will requests for continuance be
