

## PA Act 127 UGI Energy Services, LLC Data Request

**Docket No. A-2012-2294474**

Line 1360 in Washington County, PA has had 13.57 miles of approximately 80-year-old 16" pipe that is not located over, under, or through a commercially navigable waterway abandoned in calendar year 2024. An inline inspection in 2022 found external corrosion damage on the line which prevented it from being returned to active service until repairs were made. The line stayed in an inactive state with all normal operations and maintenance tasks performed as if it was an active pipeline until it was declared officially abandoned in accordance with 49 CFR 192.727 in 2024.

The 1360 pipeline was vented and purged with nitrogen on 1/19/2024 and disconnected from all potential sources and supplies of gas on 1/22/2024. The ends of the pipeline were sealed. No vaults were abandoned as part of the line abandonment. No service to customers was discontinued as a result of this abandonment. A PAPUC gas safety inspector conducted an inspection on the abandonment process of the 1360 line on 3/7/2024. PAPUC was notified of the completion of the abandonment process on 6/18/2024 after final operations and maintenance tasks were performed.
