The Bureau of Audits has reviewed Duquesne Light Company's letter in lieu of the quarterly Smart Meter Charge (SMC) filing submitted on March 21, 2025. The letter indicates that the rate will remain unchanged at zero.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Smart Meter Charge (SMC) charge for the three-month period of April 1, 2025 through June 30, 2025 is consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, is permitted to remain effective as filed.

The SMC charge is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
