
These reports represent a "snapshot" of residential statistical data as of December 31, 2024, and cover the following metrics:

- 1) The number of residential active accounts with an arrearage of \$10,000.00 or more.
- 2) The number of medical certificates/renewals submitted, and the number of medical certificates accepted by the utility.

After a thorough review of our collection database, including all active residential accounts, as well as those active delinquent CAP accounts with an accumulated pre-program arrearage of \$10,000.00 or more, Columbia has completed many outreach efforts with customers with overdue balances and is pleased to report that it has only three active residential account with an arrearage of \$10,000.00 or more at the time of the report (taken December 31, 2024).
