

I. APPROVED RESPONSES TO DATA REQUESTS

1. Regarding EGS License – Does Approved Energy II, LLC intend to abandon its EGS license?

Response to Request No. 1:

Yes; Approved intends to abandon its EGS license following the transfer of all Pennsylvania electric customers to NextEra. Following the transfer, Approved will have no remaining electric customers in Pennsylvania. However, Approved cannot at this time provide a date certain by which it will cease operations in Pennsylvania. Approved intends to complete the transfer of all its Pennsylvania customers to NextEra by December 31, 2025, and to take all the requisite steps to abandon its EGS license in Q1 2026, including obtaining any necessary regulatory approvals.

2. Regarding Certificate of Service – Please provide a Certificate of Service as proof of service of Approved Energy II, LLC’s filing on the Bureau of Investigation & Enforcement, the Office of Consumer Advocate, the Office of Small Business Advocate, the Office of the Attorney General, the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue, and all electric distribution companies in whose service territory applicants are licensed to operate (template attached).





We hope this message finds you well. We are delighted to share some exciting news with you: our company is growing and transforming.
