**JOINT STATUS REPORT OF  
DUQUESNE LIGHT COMPANY AND TONYA LEE BROWN**

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW MARY D. LONG:

Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light” or the “Company”) submits the following Joint Status Report on behalf of the Company and Tonya Lee Brown (“Complainant”), pursuant to the Interim Order Granting Motion for Further Continuance entered in this proceeding (“Interim Order”) on February 18, 2025. The Interim Order requires Duquesne Light and the Complainant to file a joint status report no later than April 4, 2025, that provides an update and recommends further proceedings. Pursuant to the Interim Order, Counsel for Duquesne Light contacted the Complainant regarding the status of the Complainant’s bankruptcy proceeding and the status of the instant Complaint. The Complainant reported that her bankruptcy petition remains pending and stated that she would like to request a 90-day continuance of the instant proceeding to pursue settlement with the Company before proceeding to hearing. Duquesne Light remains willing to work with the Complainant in an attempt to resolve the Complaint without the need for a formal evidentiary hearing and agrees with Ms. Brown’s request for a 90-day continuance.

Duquesne Light respectfully requests that Administrative Law Judge Mary D. Long accept this Status Report and continue this proceeding for 90 days to allow the parties additional time to discuss settlement.
