**INTERIM ORDER
GRANTING MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL CONTINUANCE**

On February 17, 2025, Ms. Brown requested a continuance, explaining that she wanted a continuance of the hearing on her complaint until her petition for bankruptcy was confirmed. Duquesne Light did not object. I granted the request by email and by order entered on February 18, 2025, directed Duquesne Light to file a status report by April 4, 2025.

As directed, Duquesne Light filed a status report stating that the parties remain in communication. Ms. Brown informed Duquesne Light that her bankruptcy petition remains pending and that she would like to request a 90-day continuance. Duquesne Light does not object to the request and represents that it is willing to continue settlement discussions with Ms. Brown to resolve the complaint informally.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the motion for a continuance by Tonya Lee Brown is granted.
2. That the Ms. Brown is directed to remain in contact with counsel for Duquesne Light, Ms. Rulli, and inform Ms. Rulli of the status of her bankruptcy petition.

3. That on or before **July 8, 2025**, counsel for Duquesne Light shall file a joint status report that provides an update and recommends further proceedings. In the event that a certificate of satisfaction is filed, or Ms. Brown otherwise withdraws her complaint, no status report shall be necessary.

4. That the parties are reminded that Commission policy encourages settlement and that they should continue to communicate with each other in an attempt to resolve their dispute.

5. That all other provisions of August 21, 2024, Prehearing Order remain in effect.
