Request for Information

1.) Question #10 of the application.

Unfortunately, “Northeast Pennsylvania” is too vague for a proper description of a territory. You will need to resubmit, clarifying the area that you intend to provide service. Your requested territory must have boundaries and is typically requested by County / Counties. The Public Utility Commission is specifically concerned with the location in which trips by your company will ORIGINATE.

Example:

To transport, by motor vehicle, persons in Limousine Service, from X, Y, and Z counties to points in Pennsylvania and return, excluding service that is under the jurisdiction of the Philadelphia Parking Authority.

2.) Verified Statement of Applicant.

Please correct the legal name of the applicant to Execudriver LLC’s on the Verified Statement of Applicant.

3.) Question #2 Verified Statement of Applicant.

A statement of ownership is not requested here. We need you to list Execudriver LLC’s relationship with other motor carrier companies here.

4.) Question #4 Verified Statement of Applicant.

Please respond with a clear description of where your vehicle will be parked in relation to the physical address. Where will the vehicle be housed?

5.) Question # 5 Verified Statement of Applicant.

You need to provide a compliant hiring policy regarding age restrictions for drivers. Please reference Title 52 of the Pennsylvania Code § 29. 503, which may be accessed at www.pacode.com.

6.) Question # 6 Verified Statement of Applicant.

Please know that the vehicle you identified on your application will not qualify for limousine service. To qualify as a luxury type vehicle, a vehicle must have air conditioning, AM/FM stereo radio, deluxe leather or deluxe fabric upholstery, deluxe wheels, or wheel covers, four doors and a wheelbase of at least 109 inches. Please correct your balance sheet information accordingly.

* A qualifying vehicle must be purchased before Commission approval.

7.) Question # 7 Verified Statement of Applicant.

Who will be conducting PA vehicle inspections ensuring your vehicle(s) with applicable Pennsylvania vehicle equipment standards (67 Pa. Code, Chapter 175)?

8.) Balance Sheet.

Based on submitted information on the application and balance sheet, the Commission determines that Execudriver LLC lacks financial position to gain a Certificate of Public Convenience. At this point it is expected that the company's account is filled and ready to commence operations with the capability to provide safe, efficient, and reliable service. All information provided should be accurate and based upon the information available on the date provided on the statement and comprised of information which is less than 6 months old. Estimates and rounded numbers are not acceptable.

A.) Please provide an improved and complete balance sheet. To show improved financial fitness you should show a substantial cash asset amount to cover any costs, such as vehicle, vehicle maintenance, insurance coverage, or possible fines, etc.

B.) Please provide supporting documentation for the revised balance sheet.

Acceptable means of support include current copies of bank statements, or notarized/official statements of account balances/ownership provided by bank officers (with current contact information) in the name of Execudriver LLC.

C.) All claimed, qualifying vehicles or land/buildings must also include proof of ownership/registration in the name of Execudriver LLC.

- As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards.

Note: It is in your best interest to provide accurate, complete, and timely responses. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier related proceedings is highly encouraged.
