ORDER
GRANTING MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING

On October 7, 2024, Jaycinah Simon (“Ms. Simon” or “Complainant”) filed a Formal Complaint (“Formal Complaint”) against Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW” or “Respondent”) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”), alleging that PGW was threatening to or has already shut off her service, that she would like a payment arrangement, and that there were incorrect charges on her bill. On November 7, 2024, PGW filed an Answer with New Matter to the Complaint. On March 10, 2025, a Hearing Notice was issued scheduling this matter for an evidentiary hearing on April 16, 2025.

On April 8, 2025, PGW filed a Motion to Continue Hearing (“Motion”). In its Motion, PGW sought a continuance of the April 16, 2025, hearing due to the unavailability of its lead counsel on the hearing date, and because PGW became aware that Ms. Simon filed a Chapter 13 bankruptcy petition with the United States Bankruptcy Court. PGW represented that Ms. Simon objected to the continuance request because the matter had been rescheduled once before¹ and she was concerned about further delaying this matter. PGW attached true and correct copies of the bankruptcy docket and PGW’s proof of claim to the Motion. Pursuant to the attachment, Ms. Simon filed the Chapter 13 bankruptcy petition on January 31, 2025.
