The complainant in the above-referenced matter, Clovernote Holdings, LLC (“Clovernote”), was previously not represented by counsel. Sometime late last year or early this year, Mr. Eckenrode, the principal of Clovernote, contacted attorney Kenneth J. Yarsky, II, of our firm to represent him in connection with this matter. Mr. Yarsky began collecting information and meeting with Mr. Eckenrode.

Then, on January 24, 2025, Mr. Yarsky suffered a serious fall. Mr. Yarsky was in the hospital for some time and is now in a rehabilitation facility. Additionally, since his fall, Mr. Yarsky has been unable to attend to any of the legal matters for which he was responsible.

Sometime at the end of February 2025, other members of the firm became aware of this pending matter. I have now assumed responsibility for the case.

On March 14, 2025, I entered my appearance. At the time of my Entry of Appearance, I had not yet received and was unable to locate any of the operative pleadings. Additionally, our client was unable to locate and provide us with copies of the pleadings. Therefore, I requested copies of the pleadings from the attorneys for the other parties and from Special Agent Mroczka. I received copies of the pleadings in late March.
