On behalf of Rasier-PA LLC ("Rasier"), enclosed is a firm check from Buchanan Ingersoll & Rooney for fifty dollars (\$50.00), which is the fine amount requested by the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement to terminate further proceedings in connection with the above-captioned Complaint ("Complaint"). The Complaint alleges that Rasier is subject to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to a license issued to Rasier at Docket No. A-2016-2580821 on January 26, 2017, authorizing the transportation of persons for compensation in Transportation Network Company ("TNC") service.
