On behalf of Rasier-PA LLC ("Rasier"), enclosed is a firm check from Buchanan Ingersoll & Rooney for two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00), which is the fine amount requested by the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement to terminate further proceedings in connection with the above-captioned Complaint ("Complaint"). The Complaint alleges that Rasier is subject to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to a license issued to Rasier at Docket No. A-2016-2580821 on January 26, 2017, authorizing the transportation of persons for compensation in Transportation Network Company ("TNC") service. In addition, the Complaint alleges that Rasier is in violation of 66 Pa.C.S. §2603.2(b)(6) by allowing a vehicle to operate without the applicable insurance carrier being aware that the vehicle was being used for TNC service.

Rasier does not contest payment of the requested fine and is forwarding this amount in order to resolve and close this Complaint.
