Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Everstream Solutions LLC ("Everstream") respectfully submits this response to the protest of Zito Media Communications, LLC ("Zito").

On March 5, 2025, Everstream Solutions LLC ("Everstream") filed an Application for Approval of the Discontinuance of Competitive Access Services in Pennsylvania. Everstream requested authority to discontinue services as soon as June 30, 2025.

On March 21, 2025, Zito filed a protest and attached a copy of its Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") comment regarding Everstream's proposed discontinuance. Zito claimed it cannot find substitute service by June 30, 2025.

Everstream has proposed to extend the discontinuance date until December 31, 2025. This will allow Zito additional time to migrate its respective services. On April 2, 2025, Everstream filed a letter with the FCC regarding this extension. Attached as Exhibit A is a copy of Everstream's FCC letter.¹

¹ The FCC Public Notice provided that Everstream's Section 214 Discontinuance Application will be deemed granted automatically on April 5, 2025, unless the FCC notifies the applicant that their grant will not be automatically effective. *See Comments Invited on Everstream Solutions LLC's Application to Discontinue Domestic Non-Dominant Carrier Telecommunications Services and/or Interconnected VoIP*, Federal Communications Commission Public Notice, DA 25-194, WC Docket No. 25-100 (Mar. 5, 2025). The FCC did not notify Everstream that the grant did not become effective on April 5, 2025.

Since that filing, commercial representatives from Everstream and Zito are in discussions to develop a plan that provides for an orderly migration of traffic by December 31, 2025. In order to allow the parties to focus their energies and resources on a network migration, Everstream requests that the PUC stay the procedural schedule in this matter for 60 days. Zito has not yet responded to Everstream's request for a continuance.


Dear Ms. Dortch,

Everstream Solutions, LLC (“Everstream”) submits this letter in response to comments filed by Sugar Valley Telephone Company d/b/a TDS Telecom (“TDS”); Block Line Systems, Inc. (“BLS”); Zito Media Communications, LLC (“Zito”); and T-Mobile. USA, Inc.

Although delay increases costs, Everstream is proposing to extend the discontinuance date until December 31, 2025, (“Extension Date”). This will allow additional time for negotiations and for customers to migrate off the PA Network.
