MOTOR CARRIER COMPLAINT

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “PUC”) is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate public utilities within the Commonwealth. The Commission has delegated its authority to initiate proceedings which are prosecutory in nature to the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and other bureaus with enforcement responsibilities. Pursuant to that delegated authority and Section 701 of the Public Utility Code, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement – Motor Carrier Division hereby represents as follows:

1. That ALIEN HOME SERVICES LLC T/A ALIEN MOVERS, Respondent, maintains a principal address at 3045 Richmond Street, Apartment 207, Philadelphia, PA 19134.
2. That on June 12, 2024, by Commission Secretarial letter, Respondent was issued a certificate of public convenience by this Commission authorizing transportation, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, of household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania at PUC utility code no. 8926949, Docket No. A-2024-3047107.
3. That PUC Enforcement Officer Douglas Wells was assigned to conduct a Safety Fitness Review (“SFR”) and initiated a series of attempts to contact the Respondent. Officer Wells, phoned, recording voicemails each time, texted and emailed the Respondent. On February 26, 2025, a letter was sent by certified mail, asking the Respondent to contact the officer. The letter was delivered to an individual on March 17, 2025, verified by the USPS website tracking. No contact has been made by the Respondent to these attempts.
4. That Respondent, by failing to respond to and achieve a satisfactory evaluation on a safety fitness review, violated 66 Pa.C.S. §§501(c) & 504. The penalty for this violation is cancellation of the certificate held by Respondent with this Commission at utility code 8926949.

WHEREFORE, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement hereby requests that the Commission revoke the certificate of public convenience issued to Alien Home Services LLC t/a Alien Movers, at PUC utility code number 8926949.
