In addition, Duquesne Light notes that pursuant to Paragraph 2 of the Prehearing Order issued on March 3rd, 2025, in this proceeding, **“You may lose the case if you do not take part in this hearing and present evidence on the issues raised. Your case may be dismissed ‘with prejudice’ which means that you will be barred from filing another complaint raising the same claim(s) and issue(s) presented in the dismissed complaint.”**

Pursuant to Paragraph 4 of the March 3, 2025, Prehearing Order, DLC is serving both redacted and unredacted versions of the Company’s proposed Exhibits on the Complainant. 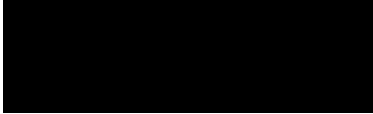


