
Dear Attorneys Ryan, Hassel and Rulli:

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) is in receipt of The York Water Company – Wastewater’s (York Water-WW’s) letter dated April 18, 2025, that requested to have the due date for providing responses to TUS Data Request Set 1 for the above-referenced Application extended to June 30, 2025. York Water-WW indicated that it needs more time to gather and prepare the requested information and materials. Please be advised that the Commission has determined that an extension of twenty (20) business days should be sufficient and, therefore, the deadline to provide responses to TUS Data Request 2 is hereby extended to **May 20, 2025**.

If York Water-WW cannot provide the requested information by May 20, 2025, York Water-WW should consider filing a letter to this docket requesting to withdraw the Application, and refile the Application when York Water-WW can provide all required information. **Please note that failure to provide complete responses may result in rejection of the Application.** 52 Pa. If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition for reconsideration from the actions of staff with the Commission within 20 days of the date this letter is served.
