Re: Generation Supply Service Compliance Filing

Dear Mr. Bakare:

By Order entered January 23, 2025, the Commission authorized Citizens' Electric Company of Lewisburg, PA (Citizens) and Wellsboro Electric Company (Wellsboro) to file tariff supplements consistent with Attachment A to the Joint Petition for Settlement filed under Docket Nos. P-2024-3049357 and P-2024-3049359, to implement a GSSR-2 E-factor on a pilot basis effective as of the June 1, 2025 commencement of DSP VII, and continuing for the duration of DSP VII. On April 17, 2025, Citizens filed Supplement No. 171 to Tariff Electric PA. P.U.C. No. 14 and Wellsboro filed Supplement No. 161 to Tariff Electric PA. P.U.C. No. 8 to become effective June 1, 2025, in compliance with the Order.<sup>1</sup>

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions in accordance with the Order and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, the supplements are effective by operation of law as of the effective dates contained on each page. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.

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<sup>1</sup> The supplements also reflect adjustments to the Generation Supply Service Rate-1 (GSSR-1) and Generation Supply Service Rate-2 (GSSR-2) Administrative Charge to take effect on June 1, 2025. The proposed rate adjustments will be reviewed by the Commission's Bureau of Audits to determine if the proposed rates are consistent with Citizens' and Wellsboro's tariffs.
