- 1.) You failed to adequately answer all aspects of question #5 of the Verified Statement of Applicant. **Please review the regulations found in Title 52 Pa Code §31.134, Title 52 Pa Code §37.204, and 49 CFR §391 to see what is required of Household Goods in Use carriers.**
  - a. Your system for conducting criminal background checks;
    - i. How often will you conduct a criminal background check?
    - ii. What would disqualify a prospective driver?
      1. In your application you stated that you would be reviewing individuals on a case-by-case basis, considering what the offense was, how long ago it occurred, and what steps they have taken to ensure that these mistakes do not reoccur. You also stated that you would disqualify applicants with any offenses such as killings, crimes against a minor, or sexual offenses. Please note, Title 52 Pa Code §31.134(c) states that a household goods carrier may not permit a person to provide moving services in a shipper's dwelling when the person was convicted of a felony or a misdemeanor under the laws of the Commonwealth or under the laws of another jurisdiction, to the extent the conviction relates adversely to that person's suitability to provide service safely and legally. While this regulation does not necessarily define what would disqualify an individual from being employed by a carrier of household goods in use authority, it is expected that the carrier maintains this standard when reviewing the background checks of prospective employees.
    - iii. How will you maintain records (record retention) of the criminal background checks performed.
