On March 24, 2025, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) received Joule EP, LLC's Application for a Natural Gas Supplier (NGS) license. On April 3, 2025, the Commission served a Deficiency Secretarial Letter requesting missing or incomplete information. On April 8, 2025 and April 11, 2025, Joule EP, LLC filed responses to the Deficiency Secretarial Letter. In order for us to complete our analysis of Joule EP, LLC's NGS Application, the Commission's Energy Industry Group requires answers to the attached questions.

Data Requests

1. Reference Application, Sections 5.a, b, and c, Compliance – Applicant stated: “*Not applicable, none*” or “*Not applicable*” in response to each of the three compliance related sections (5.a, b, and c). However, there appear to be filings in at least one jurisdiction against the applicant and/or people named in the application. Of note is a civil action filed by Chrislynn Energy Services, Inc. in the United States District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania, at Civil Action No. 2:24-cv-01355. If this case involves either the applicant and/or people listed in the application, please resubmit the application with Sections 5.a, b, and c fully disclosed. Applicant must list and identify all such proceedings (active or closed within the last five years), by name, subject and citation; whether before an administrative body or in a judicial forum. Provide a statement as to the resolution or present status of any such proceedings listed.
2. Reference Application, Section 7.b, Financial Fitness – Please provide three recent consecutive months of applicant’s bank statements.
3. Reference Application, Section 8.e, Technical Fitness – Applicant failed to provide detailed professional resumes of its chief officers, to include detailed descriptions on all experience and activities including date ranges. Please provide the missing documentation.
4. Reference Application, Section 11, Affidavits – The Affidavits submitted in response to the Deficiency Letter are unacceptable because they were changed after they were notarized. Please submit a new Application Affidavit and a new Operations Affidavit.
