- 1.) You failed to adequately answer all aspects of question #5 of the Verified Statement of Applicant. **Please review the regulations found in Title 52 Pa Code §31.134, Title 52 Pa Code §37.204, and 49 CFR §391 to see what is required of Household Goods in Use carriers.**
 - a. Your system for conducting criminal background checks;
 - i. How often will you conduct a criminal background check?
 1. In your answer to the Commission's previous data request you stated that prospective hires will undergo a criminal background check prior to being hired, and if any new legal issues arise. This policy does not comply with the regulations found in **Title 52 Pa Code §31.134**. Please revise your policy regarding the frequency of record checks to comply with the regulations mentioned above.
 - ii. How will you maintain records (record retention) of the criminal background checks performed.
 1. In your answer to the Commission's previous data request you stated that the criminal background checks conducted on prospective hires will not be retained, only their unique control number provided by the PATCH system will be maintained. This policy does not comply with the regulations found in **Title 52 Pa Code §31.134**. Please revise your policy regarding record retention of criminal background checks to comply with the regulations mentioned above.
