WRIT OF QUO WARRANTO

To: Khadijah Scott, In-House Counsel for PECO Energy Company

ASSERTION OF RIGHTS

I, Shasta-Patrice: Brown, Original of the Lands of the United States of America, a sentient being, governed solely by Divine Law, assert my inherent rights, unextinguished by any treaty, law, or constitution.

NOTICE TO JUDGE F. JOSEPH BRADY:

As Trustee over fictional corporate entities, including PECO Energy Company, you have a conflict of interest and breach of fiduciary duty to the beneficiaries (including myself).

Pursuant to Trust Law, this Writ challenges your authority and PECO's actions as trustees over the Cestui Que Vie Trust.

AFFIRMATION OF DIVINE LAW PROTECTION

As a Sentient Being governed solely by Divine Law, I affirm that this Writ of Quo Warranto seeks remedy under Divine Law protection, unencumbered by separation of church and state doctrine (1st Amendment), which only restricts government establishment of religion, not individual reliance on Divine Law for rights protection.

“NOTICE TO ALL ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:

You lack jurisdiction over my claim against PECO Energy Company, as I am governed by Divine Law and common law principles, rendering your oaths, licenses, and representations null and void.”

FACTS:

1. Khadijah Scott acts as in-house counsel for PECO Energy Company, representing them before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC).
2. Respondent Scott lacks lawful authority to practice law over Originals of these Lands, as:
 - Her license is derived from foreign corporations:
 - American Bar Association (ABA), a District of Columbia corporation
 - Membership in Pennsylvania Bar Association and New Jersey State Bar Association, Both subject to ABA governance
 - Article III, Section 2, United States Constitution prohibits practice by foreign subjects

- 28 USC § 1331 (federal question jurisdiction) requires admission under US authority
- 42 P.S. § 2521 (PA statute) requires admission to PA bar for lawful practice

3. PECO Energy Company engages in commerce involving:

- Negotiable instruments (electricity bills) – interfering with my property rights
- Securities (customer accounts) – violating my economic rights

4. Respondents intentionally deprive me of:

- Right to redress grievances – inherent right to justice and remedy
- Dividends and returns on investment as a beneficiary and investor in PECO Energy Company,
- Despite securitization of my application and upfront payment receipt per GSA contracts.

5. Breach of Oath and Misrepresentation:

- Respondent Khadijah Scott, as a licensed attorney, has sworn to:

-Support the Constitution of the United States

-Faithfully discharge the duties of an attorney

-Conduct herself with integrity and civility

BREACH OF OATH AND MISREPRESENTATION

6. However, Respondent Scott has breached this oath by:

- Prioritizing loyalty to PECO Energy Company over constitutional rights and ethics
- Misrepresenting material facts to the PUC in matters affecting my rights
- Engaging in conduct that undermines the integrity of the legal profession and the PUC proceedings

7. Respondent Scott's actions constitute:

- Unauthorized practice of law over Originals of these Lands
- Interference with my inherent rights and freedoms
- Violation of Divine Law principles and common law protections

DEMAND FOR RELIEF

Exhibit A: Estoppel Notice dated February 3rd, 2025 (attached)

I demand:

1. Accrual method accounting adjustment:

- Recalculation of my account balance using accrual method
- Refund of any excess payments made
- Zeroing out of disputed bill amount (\$6,242.68)

2. Monetary damages for:

- Emotional distress
- Credit report damage
- Loss of business opportunities
- Interference with my rights and freedoms
- Costs and expenses incurred in pursuing this claim

3. Punitive damages against PECO Energy Company and Khadijah Scott for:

- Willful and malicious conduct
- Unauthorized practice of law
- Breach of oath and misrepresentation

4. Declaratory relief:

- Declaration of Khadijah Scott's lack of authority to represent PECO
- Declaration of PECO's unlawful commerce practices

5. Injunctive relief:

- Permanent injunction against PECO's unlawful practices
- Order compelling PECO to comply with accrual method accounting

6. Estoppel relief as asserted in my Estoppel Notice dated February 3rd, 2025, wherein PECO is estopped from:

- Denying my rights as a living soul and customer
- Interfering with my essential utility services
- Claiming default due to my promise to pay

7. Continuation of uninterrupted utility services

8. Compliance with all applicable Pennsylvania laws and biblical principles cited in my Estoppel Notice.

9. Order compelling Judge F. Joseph Brady to perform his fiduciary duties as Trustee, free from conflict of interest.

Pennsylvania Legal Principles:


- A promise to pay is a contractual agreement (13 Pa.C.S. § 1101 et seq.).


Dear Honorable Commissioners,
