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**NOTIFICATION OF PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION**

Pursuant to the requirements of 52 Pa. Code § 59.38, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (“National Fuel”), hereby files the following Notification of Proposed Construction:

1. Description and Location of Proposed Work. National Fuel is planning to install approximately 11,986’ of 8.625” OD high-strength coated steel in Parker Township and Bruin Borough, Butler County, PA. The project will take place along an existing right of way between Washington St. and Annisville Rd. The project will be bid out and awarded by National Fuel and constructed by a National Fuel approved contractor.
2. Type of Facility. 8.625” OD steel gas facilities.
3. Estimated Starting Date. Construction is expected to begin on or about June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2025.
4. Estimated Completion Date. Construction is expected to be completed by September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
5. Design Pressure. The pipeline will be designed for a maximum allowable operating pressure of 227 psig.
6. Estimated Cost. The cost of the pipeline project is \$6,000,000.
