On March 24, 2025, PECO Energy Company (PECO) filed a request for exclusion of major outage (Exclusion Request) for reliability reporting purposes in accordance with the requirements of the Commission's Order entered May 11, 2004, at M-00991220. On April 3, 2025, via Secretarial Letter the Commission requested additional information concerning the Exclusion Request and extended the consideration period to April 30, 2025. On April 24, 2025 PECO responded. In order to review the additional information requested, the Commission hereby extends the consideration period of PECO's Exclusion Request to May 30, 2025.
