PHILADELPHIA GAS WORKS' MOTION TO CONTINUE

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §1.15, Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW”) hereby files this Motion to Continue the evidentiary hearing in this matter, which is scheduled for Wednesday, May 14, 2025. In support of this Motion, PGW states as follows:

1. By notice dated March 26, 2025, the Commission scheduled a telephonic hearing in this matter for Wednesday, May 14, 2025 at 10:00 a.m., before Administrative Law Judge Marta Guhl.
2. In the Complaint, Michael Shields (“Complainant”) indicated that he is having a reliability, safety, or quality problem with his gas service that has led him to question the accuracy of the bills.
3. PGW is in the process of investigating the issues raised by the Complainant relating to the gas meter at the Service Address, which has required coordinating with the Complainant and his landlord to schedule a PGW field visit to the Service Address.
4. PGW will not be able to conclude its investigation prior to the scheduled hearing date.
5. PGW has spoken with the Complainant to discuss PGW’s request for a continuance in this matter; the Complainant has stated that he does not have an objection to PGW’s request.

WHEREFORE, PGW requests that the hearing scheduled for Wednesday, January 22, 2025, in the above captioned matter be continued.
