**PHILADELPHIA GAS WORKS' MOTION TO CONTINUE**

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §1.15, Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW”) hereby files this Motion to Continue the evidentiary hearing in this matter, which is scheduled for Tuesday, May 6, 2025. In support of this Motion, PGW states as follows:

1. By notice dated December 13, 2024, the Commission scheduled a hearing in this matter for Thursday, March 13, 2025 at 10:00 a.m., before Deputy Chief Administrative Law Judge Christopher Pell.
2. On February 26, 2025, the complainant requested a continuance via email to the Commission, and the hearing was rescheduled to May 6, 2025, at 10:00am, also before DCALJ Pell.
3. Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.231(a) and the Prehearing Order issued in this matter, PGW is working with the Complainant to reach a resolution in this matter.
4. The complainant has indicated that he needs additional time to make the arrangements necessary to effectuate settlement, and should be ready to reach resolution on May 8<sup>th</sup>, which is unfortunately two days after the scheduled hearing date.
5. PGW has spoken with Mr. Mathis via email to discuss this request to continue the hearing.
6. Mr. Mathis has stated that he has no objection to PGW’s Motion and that he agrees that a short continuance should allow the parties to resolve the outstanding issues.

WHEREFORE, PGW requests that the hearing scheduled for Tuesday, May 6, 2025, in the above captioned matter be continued.
