This is to inform you that Complainants Roy Cumming: docket number C :2019-3007995 and Liza Mousios docket number C-2019-3007989 shall imminently be filing a motion of reconsideration to the Public Utility Commission.

NOTICE OF IMMINENTLY FILING A MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION TO THE PUC

AFFIRMATION THAT THE CURRENT ELECTRIC METER REMAINS IN PLACE DURING ONGOING  
LEGAL PROCEEDINGS

- 1) On April 30th, 2025, complainants Liza Mousios and Roy Cumming filed with the PUC an Affirmation that the current electric meter must remain in place during ongoing legal proceedings.
- 2) Concomitantly, Complainants filed a notice of Imminently Filing a Motion for reconsideration to the PUC.
- 3) Complainant had been informed that her current electric meter will remain in place during her ongoing case.
- 4) PUC and Met-Ed must abide by this agreement.
- 5) Complainant now adamantly affirms this fact and agreement.
- 6) The current meter must remain in place until final disposition in this case is made at the appellate court level, whether it be the Commonwealth Court or the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania, or at the Federal court level.
- 7) In addition, other legal and public actions are in process whose outcomes may well affect the path forward of Complainants' case.
- 8) Decision pending in the Declaratory Judgment of petitioner Nancy Colbert. The Commonwealth Court sent this case on to the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania.
- 9) The burgeoning movement of the opt- out bill introduced by Senator Doug Mastriano and Representative Brett Miller and Representative Eric Nelson. As you know, the health czar was inundated with protest letters against the smart meter and in support of the opt -out bill.

- 10) The critical mass interest in the high- publicity case of Ms. Mousios. Robert F Kennedy Jr. and his organization Children's Health Defense published an expose about the suffering and plight of Ms. Mousios who had to move into a tent to avoid the extreme sickness from the neighbor's smart meter, and whose dogs sickened and two died from the neighbor's smart meter. Robert F Kennedy Jr. and his organization, Children's Health Defense Fund, continue to support Ms. Mousios in her fight against the forced deployment of a smart meter at her residence. On April 28<sup>th</sup>, Ms. Mousios received a call from an interested Senator in her case.
- 11) THE NEW YORK TIMES has also taken an interest in Ms. Mousios' case as they have published other articles about the dangers of electromagnetic radiation and the sickening effects of smart meters, not limited to but including September 2022. It should be noted that Ms. Mousios was a proofreader and editor for a New York Times Bestseller, so she has a connection with The New York Times.
- 12) Complainant affirms that Met Ed/ FirstEnergy will allow the current electric meter to remain in place during Complainants' ongoing case and legal proceeding to higher courts, even though this may mean Federal court hearings. Complainant also affirms that the current electric meter shall stay in place until final decisions are rendered and related cases ie.supra are finalized, as these may impact the legal path forward for Complainants.
- 13) The motion for reconsideration filed by Complainants shall ensue imminently.
