TO ALL PARTIES OF RECORD

Application of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for approval to alter the public crossings (DOT 051 674 J) and (DOT 149 033 D) by removal and replacement of the existing bridge structure where SR 0068 crosses, above grade the tracks of Bessemer & Lake Erie Railroad Company, Buffalo & Pittsburgh Railroad Inc., and CSX Transportation Inc., located in Butler and Summit Townships, Butler County, and the allocation of costs incident thereto.

To Whom It May Concern:

On March 6, 2025, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT), through counsel, filed, in the case referenced above: (1) a praecipe to withdraw its August 6, 2024 Petition to Transfer Jurisdiction regarding Railway Allegheny and Western Railway Company; and (2) a praecipe to withdraw its August 6, 2024 Petition to Transfer Jurisdiction regarding Railway Bessemer and Lake Erie Railroad Company. No party or person has filed any objection to either of PennDOT's August 6, 2024 Petitions to Transfer.


Pursuant to Section 1.82 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) regulations, 52 Pa. Code § 1.82(a):

A party that desires to terminate an uncontested matter or proceeding before final decision by the Commission or otherwise desires to withdraw a submittal or pleading, shall file a petition for leave to withdraw the appropriate document. If no party objects to the petition within 10 days of service, the matter may be stricken by the Commission or by the presiding officer.

As more than ten (10) days have passed since PennDOT filed its praecipes to withdraw the two Petitions to Transfer referenced herein, and no party has objected to either petition, the Commission hereby strikes the Petitions to Transfer and henceforth, the Petitions to Transfer shall have no effect whatsoever on any person, party or matter pending before the Commission.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.31 and 5.44, file a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The Petition shall be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission or sent to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, and must be filed within twenty (20) days, or if no timely request is made, the action will be deemed to be a final action of the Commission. The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request; (2) the case docket number (it is provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter); (3) the party on whose behalf the petition is made; (4) a Certificate of Service on the other parties of record; and (5) a Verification with original signature in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36.
