Your answers should be verified per 52 Pa Code § 1.36. Accordingly, you must provide the following statement with your responses:



Request for Information

1.) Question #10 of the application.

The Territory description is not acceptable. Please revise your request or verify that the below example is what you now intend. Please make corrections with the Commission's criteria in mind or verify that the example below is what you now intend.

Example:

To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in Paratransit Service, from points in the Blair County, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

- This example is not limiting you to a vehicle type, activity regarding non-emergency medical transportation, or transportation for virtually any reason. You can leave Blair County and return. This language would give your company the broadest customer base to work with.
- Please reference the attached list of territory/service templates on the last pages of this data request for proper verbiage.

2.) Question # 2 of the Verified Statement.

A statement of ownership is not requested here. We need a list of M&J Well LLC's current affiliations (owner, manager, controls) with any other motor carrier companies with the description of connections to include the full name, licensing authority and corresponding number(s).

3.) Question # 4 of the Verified Statement.

A) Please include the plan on how you plan to secure customers' sensitive physical documents.

B) Please respond with a clear description of where your vehicle will be parked in relation to the physical address.

4.) Question #5 of the verified statements.

In case of expansion, please review the requirements of the following chapters of 52 *Pa Code*, which may be accessed at www.pacode.com and provide a required plan for drivers that demonstrates compliance with the below cited statutes.

A. § 29.504. *Driver History*. How often will a driver license check be done?

B. § 29.505. *Criminal history*. How often will a record check be done and what are the disqualifications of employment?

5.) Question #7 of the Verified Statement.

As part of your vehicle maintenance plan, please explain your trip inspection. If available, submit documents to be used for these inspections.

6.) Financial Position.

- A. You are required to provide a complete and dated balance sheet. This is not optional.
- The balance sheet must be dated, comprised of information which is less than 6 months old. All the information provided should be accurate and based upon the information available on the date provided on the statement.
- B. If you do choose to input the “work” vehicle amount which may benefit you, include proof of ownership with a title and/or registration in the name of the applicant (M&J Well LLC). Provide proof of ownership in the name of applicant for **ALL** claimed property.
- The information provided is also to be strictly limited to assets and debts held by the applicant (M&J Well LLC), and not the individual member(s). Any property listed must be registered or titled to the corporation – personal property should not be included.
- C. At this point it is expected that the company’s account is filled and ready to commence operations with the capability to provide safe, efficient, and reliable service. Provide a copy of a bank statement (with account number redacted), or an official, notarized letter from a bank officer, verifying acceptable account holdings for M&J Well LLC.
- Any assets which may need transferred to the applicant should happen prior to adding them to the balance sheet.
 - As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards.

Note: If you are having trouble with your reply and/or completing a balance sheet, you are encouraged to consult with an attorney and/or a financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier related proceedings.

PASSENGER CARRIER TERRITORY EXAMPLES AND EXPLANATIONS:

The Public Utility Commission is specifically concerned with the location in which trips by your company will ORIGINATE. Your requested territory must have boundaries and is typically requested by County / Counties.

Take care in choosing the correct language. You must file a new application and pay an additional fee to amend any approved territory.

Examples below:

1) To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, from points in (County name/names here), to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

This territory means that you are not limited on a vehicle type, not limited to the type of activity regarding non-emergency medical transportation, or transportation for virtually any reason. This language would give your company the broadest customer base to work from.

2) To transport persons, by motor vehicles, in Paratransit service, in wheelchair vans, between points in (County name/names here).

This territory means that you must:

a) provide all services in wheelchair vans, and

b) could travel only between points within the county or counties requested as your territory. You could not leave those counties and return.

3) To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, limited to persons whose personal convictions prevent them from owning or operating motor vehicles, from points in (County name/names here), to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

This language is strictly for companies that specialize in transporting Amish people, this is NOT to be used for persons who are elderly and cannot drive, or who do not have a vehicle for any other reason.
