To Whom It May Concern:

By Secretarial Letter dated April 21, 2025 (*April 2025 Secretarial Letter*), the Commission issued the Initial Decision of Administrative Law Judge Alphonso Arnold III in this matter. As noted in the *April 2025 Secretarial Letter*, Exceptions are due within twenty days of that letter (*i.e.*, on or before Monday, May 12, 2025) and Replies to Exceptions are due within ten days after that date (*i.e.*, on or before Thursday, May 22, 2025).

On May 7, 2025, the Commission received a Petition for Extension of Time to File Reply Exceptions to the Initial Decision (Petition) from Orpheus and Kimberly Hanley (Complainants). In the Petition, the Complainants requested a 15-day extension (*i.e.*, on or before Thursday, May 22, 2025) due to being out of town on emergency business.

The Commission's Regulation at 52 Pa. Code § 1.15 permits the Commission to grant an extension of time for good cause shown before or after the pertinent time period has expired. The Commission finds that the Respondent has established good cause for the requested extension of time. As a result, the Commission will extend the period for filing Exceptions; and Exceptions will be due no later than ten (10) days from the date of this Secretarial Letter. Accordingly, the new deadline for filing Replies to Exceptions shall be ten (10) days from the date that Exceptions are due.
