On May 14, 2025, UGI Utilities Inc. – Electric Division (UGI), submitted the results of its Alternative Energy Portfolio Standards Act Request for Proposal Solicitation (Spring 2025 Solicitation) for the compliance period beginning June 1, 2024, and ending May 31, 2025, for part of default service program GSR-1 Group and all GSR-2 Group customers.

This filing is submitted in accordance with the Default Service Plan for the Period of June 1, 2025, through May 31, 2029, filed by UGI and approved by Commission Order, entered February 20, 2025, at P-2024-3049343 and G-2024-3049351.

UGI requests that the Commission approve the bid results for the Spring 2025 Solicitation by noon of business on May 15, 2025.

Further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time, since the bid results from the Spring 2025 Solicitation appear to have been conducted in accordance with the Default Service Plan approved by the Commission Order and are consistent with the expected market prices that UGI's third-party monitor provided. Therefore, we certify the bid results submitted for the Spring 2025 Solicitation.

We direct UGI to disclose the results of the Spring 2025 Solicitation in accordance with the Commission's Secretarial Letter in Re: Disclosure of Default Service Solicitation Results and Creation of a Default Service Rate Calculation Model, issued October 12, 2010, at Docket No. M-2009-2082042.
