**EXCEPTIONS OF HEIDI FIEDLER, COMPLAINANT, to Initial Decision dated April 29, 2025
Heidi Fiedler v. Metropolitan Edison Company, Docket No. C-2018-3003642**

Dear Mr. Homsher:

My Exceptions to the Initial Decision dated April 29, 2025 issued by Administrative Law Judge Emily DeVoe are based on the fact that I did not receive either a mailed or emailed Prehearing Order for the Telephone Hearing held on March 5, 2025. This order would have specified the Bridge Number and the PIN Number for participants to attend this hearing.

Under the "History of the Proceedings," on page 27, last paragraph, ALJ DeVoe states "Her email to me dated March 3, 2025, and read, "Good evening, please find attached two additional pictures for the hearing scheduled on March 5." And in the "Findings of Fact," page 33, paragraph 42 re-states this same email. On page 34, paragraph 45 states that "Ms. Fiedler did not request a continuance of the March 5, 2025 hearing, nor did she contact the Commission to explain her failure to appear was unavoidable." However, these statements are not correct because they fail to include the last line of my email. I have attached a copy of the email chain that was sent to all parties. On March 3, 2025, my email, in line 3, requests "Please send the telephone conference phone number-I did not receive it." I never received an email response (or written response) to this request from ALJ DeVoe or anyone else at the Commission.

I disagree with the page 36 discussion that states that I "voluntarily chose not to" participate in the March 5 hearing because the Commission prevented me from participating by not providing the bridge number and PIN number for this hearing. Furthermore, I object to the Conclusions of Law 4 and 5, since my due process rights were not protected and therefore I could not provide my evidence for seeking relief.

Accordingly, I request that the Commission overturn this decision to dismiss my complaint and order a new hearing.
