
This is a new mover. This tariff is filed by Charlie Morris Consulting LLC on behalf of Franklin Matias, Jr., Owner, Full House Logistics LLC t/a Let's Move Philadelphia. The Issue Date for this tariff is May 16th, 2025, and it is filed on one day's notice under authority of PA Code, Title 52, Section 23.42 with an Effective Date for Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 1 of May 19th, 2025.

Per the PUC website, it appears that Insurance Form E for liability coverage have been received and accepted. We are still waiting on Form H for cargo coverage to be submitted by the underwriter at the insurance carrier.

SECTION 1: General Rules

- 1.1 This tariff establishes charges for the transportation of household goods shipments between points in Pennsylvania and transported distances of forty (40) miles or less and transported distances in excess of forty (40) miles.
- 1.2 TRAVEL CHARGE (applies to shipments transported distances of forty (40) miles or less)
The travel charge is based on the combined mileage from the carrier's terminal to the first point of origin and from the final destination back to the carrier's terminal.

| DISTANCE | TRAVEL CHARGE | DISTANCE | TRAVEL CHARGE |
|---------------|--|---------------|--|
| 10 - 15 miles | 1 hour | 16 - 30 miles | 1 hour plus \$50.00 vehicle charge per vehicle |
| 31 - 50 miles | 1 1/2 hours plus \$50.00 vehicle charge per vehicle | 51 - 70 miles | 2 hours plus \$50.00 vehicle charge per vehicle |

When the total distance exceeds 70 miles, apply an additional 1/2 hour plus \$50.00 vehicle charge per vehicle for each additional 20 miles. Mileage can be calculated using computer software designed to calculate miles, such as, Google Maps, MapQuest or TruckRouter or actual road miles.

SECTION 2 - HOURLY RATES

- 2.1 Charges in this section apply to shipments transported forty (40) miles or less ONLY

Packing & unpacking labor will be performed using hourly rates shown on Page 2 of this tariff. The applicable Travel Charge will apply.

SECTION 4 - PROTECTION PLAN

(applies to shipments transported distances of forty (40) miles or less and distances in excess of forty (40) miles)

- 4.1 Carrier offers Basic Liability Coverage of \$.60 per pound per article at no additional cost. If requested, carrier will provide coverage of \$10.00 per item with a total \$250.00 deductible at an additional cost of \$100.00.

SECTION 5 - PAYMENT TERMS

- 5.1 The invoice for shipments transported distances less than forty (40) miles will be prepared by the driver 30-45 minutes prior to completion of the job. On shipments transported distances in excess of forty (40) miles, payment is required prior to delivery. The crew will have a POS machine to collect payment. If shipper is paying by cash, certified check or cashier's check, the payment is to be given to the driver. Credit cards are also an acceptable means of payment. On shipments with storage, carrier will only process the payment through a credit card.

SECTION 7 - MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES

THE FOLLOWING NOTES APPLY TO SHIPMENTS TRAVELING BETWEEN POINTS IN PENNSYLVANIA AND TRANSPORTED IN EXCESS OF FORTY (40) MILES:

SPACE RESERVATION FOR A PORTION OF VEHICLE

Subject to the availability of equipment, shipper may reserve a portion of the capacity of a vehicle by ordering a specific quantity of space, and accepting transportation charges based on actual weight of the shipment subject to minimum weights as follows:

When shipment consists entirely of household goods: 300 cubic feet or less - 2,100 pounds

More than 300 cubic feet - 700 pounds per each 100 cubic feet or fraction ordered thereof.

TOTAL CUBIC FEET OF SPACE RESERVATION CANNOT EXCEED THE TOTAL CUBIC FEET OF VEHICLE USED TO TRANSPORT THE SHIPMENT.

Bill of Lading and Freight Bill to be marked or stamped:

SPACE RESERVATION WITH THE CUBIC FEET ORDERED

CUSTOMER SIGNATURE IS REQUIRED FOR SERVICES

When due to problems with access to or from a residence (excessive long carry, steep grade, etc.), carrier may assess a charge for shuttle service. Cost for shuttle service is \$15.00 per 100 pounds (includes the shuttle vehicle and additional labor required to perform the shuttle).

When customer does not arrive at destination to accept delivery at the time agreed upon with the carrier, the carrier may assess a charge for waiting time based on \$50.00 per hour per vehicle and \$75.00 per crewmember subject to the following: For shipments transported 200 miles or less, customer is entitled to one (1) hour of waiting time at no additional charge and on shipments transported in excess of 200 miles, customer is entitled to two (2) hours of waiting time at no additional charge.

When a shipment has stairs, elevator or long carrier at origin, extra stops or long carries, the following charges will apply based on the actual weight of the shipment and subject the following:

Stairs - (a flight is defined as six steps or more) - Additional cost per flight is \$2.00 per 100 pounds

When an elevator is present at origin or destination, the additional charge per elevator is \$3.00 per 100 pounds

Long Carry - (a long carry is defined as each 50 feet or fraction thereof after the first 75 feet - Additional cost per long carry is \$2.00 per 100 pounds - (first 75 feet of a long carry is performed at no additional charge)

When an extra stop or extra stops are included in the shipment, the additional cost is \$60.00 per extra stop

INTRASTATE FUEL COST RECOVERY CHARGE

The following Fuel Cost Recovery Surcharge will apply as follows on shipments of household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania, transported distances in excess of forty (40) miles.

- (a) The Fuel Cost Recovery Surcharge will be calculated using a "BASE PRICE PER GALLON" of \$1.267.
- (b) On the first Monday of each calendar month, the "CENTRAL ATLANTIC" average price per gallon of diesel fuel will be determined based on the price stated by the U. S. Department of Energy (DOE), Energy Information Administration (EIA) survey of "Retail-On-Highway Diesel Prices." This price will be obtained by calling the DOE Fuel Hot Line at 202-586-6966 or via the DOE Internet Website at www.eia.doe.gov.
- (c) If the first Monday of the calendar month is a federal holiday, the price will be determined based on the stated DOE price available on the next subsequent business day (Tuesday).
- (d) The DOE fuel price obtained will then become effective on the fifteenth (15th) day of the same month. The adjustment determined will apply for shipments loaded beginning on the 15th day of the month and remain in effect through the 14th day of the subsequent following month starting from the effective date of this item.

THIS PROCESS WILL CONTINUE MONTH AFTER MONTH BASED ON THE "NEW" MONTHLY FUEL COSTS.

FOR EXAMPLE

If the reported price of self-service diesel fuel determined on Monday, 10/01/2018, is \$3.447 per gallon, that amount will apply for the purpose of calculating the difference between that amount and the base price of \$1.267 per gallon for shipments loaded as of October 15, 2018 to November 14, 2018.

TO DETERMINE THE FUEL ADJUSTMENT AMOUNT TO APPLY, FIRST DETERMINE THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE "BASE PRICE PER GALLON" AND THE MOST CURRENT SELF-SERVICE DIESEL FUEL PRICE PER GALLON.

EXAMPLE

IF TOTAL MILEAGE IS 240. AVERAGE MILEAGE PER GALLON IS FIVE (5). FUEL CONSUMED IN GALLONS IS FORTY-EIGHT (48).
INCREASED FUEL DIFFERENCE IS \$2.18 TIMES 48 GALLONS OR \$104.64 SURCHARGE.
