INTERIM ORDER
GRANTING REQUEST FOR CONTINUANCE and REQUIRING
REPRESENTATION

A hearing was scheduled in the above matter for May 20, 2025. By email, counsel for FirstEnergy forwarded a message from Amanda Coats on behalf of the Complainant, Kitten Scoop, requesting a continuance of the hearing. Counsel for FirstEnergy did not object to the continuance. I cancelled May 20, 2025, hearing and notified the parties that I would grant the continuance.

The Commission’s regulations provide that only an individual may represent themselves.¹ Accordingly, in order to participate in these proceedings, it appears that Kitten Scoop must be represented by counsel licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth in this matter.²

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the request for continuance by the Complainant is granted.

2. That Kitten Scoop shall cause an attorney licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to enter an appearance on behalf of Kitten Scoop in accordance with 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.21 1.25. Kitten Scoop may seek reconsideration of this order upon showing that there is a basis that would permit Kitten Scoop to proceed as a non-represented individual.

3. Failure to secure representation by counsel where one is required by law may result in dismissal of the complaint.

4. That on or before **June 6, 2025**, counsel for FirstEnergy shall provide a joint status report which provides at least three alternate dates when all parties and their witnesses are available for a rescheduled hearing or requests a further continuance. In the event that a certificate of satisfaction is filed, no status report will be necessary.

5. That the parties are reminded that Commission policy encourages settlement and that they should continue to communicate with each other in an attempt to resolve their dispute.
